Dialogue and Workshop 4: Bridging NTA to National Inclusion Accounts (NIA): Towards Socioeconomic Insights for Inclusive Policy Design at Lotus Suite 1-2





A. Introduction:

In the past year, the National Transfer Accounts network reached a major milestone: we now have estimates of the generational economy from 100 countries.



The 15th Global Meeting will provide an opportunity for researchers and policymakers to present and discuss evidence on how population growth and changing age structures influence macroeconomic performance, gender and generational equity, public finances, and opportunities for meeting sustainable development goals, and what policies can help. The National Transfer Accounts (NTA) network welcomes participation from members of its country research teams and from those in government agencies, international organizations, public and private research institutions, media, and universities.

The meeting will be held on March 10th - 13th, 2025:

- **The first day** of the conference will be targeted to a general audience of policy makers, media, researchers, students, and the public. Issues relevant to Thailand, Asia, and immediate neighbors will be highlighted.
- **The subsequent days** of paper presentations, workshops, training programs, and discussion groups will be targeted to members or prospective members of the NTA network but anyone interested in economic demography is welcome. Training workshops will be

offered each day, including NTA basics and extended topics such as measuring the gendered economy using National Time Transfer Accounts

B. Note Before You Go:

Passport and Visa:



All foreign visitors entering Thailand must have a passport. In addition, **please check with the Thailand embassy** in your respective country **regarding visa requirements so that the NTA Bangkok's team can facilitate.**



Electricity


