Generational Economy in a COVID-19 pandemic context:

Implications for SDG achievements in Africa

27, 28 and 29 October 2021, Somone, Senegal

From 28 to 30 October 2019, the first edition of the Africa NTA Conference was held by the Regional Consortium for Research in Generational Economy (CREG) in partnership with the United Nations Population Fund's Regional Office for West and Central Africa (UNFPA/WCARO) and the Economic Commission for Africa's Sub-Regional Office for West Africa (ECA/BSR-WA).

Nearly 200 researchers and experts from thirty countries attended the Conference on Population and Development. Through the various sessions and plenary sessions, issues that are challenging Africa's socio-economic and sustainable development were addressed.

One of the conference resolutions is that it should be held every two years. In order to comply with such a resolution, the Regional Consortium for Research in Generational Economy (CREG), in collaboration with its various partners, including the ECA/BSR-AO and UNFPA/WCARO, is launching the initiative to hold the second edition of the conference in 2021.

This initiative is part of an African context shaped by the COVID-19 pandemic, given the associated unprecedented health crisis with important economic and social impacts. Thus, CREG, representing the NTA Council Network in Africa, in synergy with its strategic partners UNFPA-WCARO, ECA/BSR-AO and all development partners, continue to play their part with the aim to bring their contribution to the issues that are affecting Africa socio-economic development.

TERMS OF SUBMISSION

Registration is exclusively online at the conference website https://ntaafrica-conference.creg-center.org/ and is conditional upon prior acceptance of the paper abstracts. Abstracts must be

submitted on the same website no later than 31 July 2021. These abstracts of maximum 400 words in French or English must include the following elements

- 1. The title of the paper
- 2. The author(s) contact details
- 3. Reference to one or two targeted sessions
- 4. The paper should include: The problem, the methodological approach, the main results obtained or expected
- 5. Four keywords

Following the selection of papers by the scientific committee, a notification will be sent to authors by email on **August 16, 2021**. The deadline for submission of full papers is **15 September**. After evaluation, the papers will be sent to authors on **15 September** for correction. Corrected papers must reach the organisers by **10 October at the latest**.

Deadline for submission of abstracts is 31 July 2021
